Brief Course Description 课程简述(中英文)								

The course is structured around two core parts: "Read Urban Texts" and "Read the Real City." The two parts are integrated through interim student presentations and facilitated discussions. By introducing and reading classic urban theory books and building on this foundation to observe real urban spaces, the course aims to equip architecture and urban design students with a comprehensive and systematic understanding of the physical environment, social structures, and political-economic dynamics of cities. Students will develop the ability to analyze and understand complex urban settings and advance spatial design interventions within them.
