Brief Course Description 课程简述(中英文)

《城市社会空间与规划》是面向建筑与城市规划学院的研究生开设的英文专业基础理论课程。这门课程以社会空间的辩证关系和社会空间理论模型的应用为主线,采用全球的视野和比较的观点,围绕"城市形态"、"城市化"、"城市性"、"城市问题"四个板块,着重探讨了世界范围内的城市化、多中心大都市区域的形态、大都市社会空间文化的多样性以及大都市社会问题等议题,从社会、政治、经济与文化等维度全面、联系地解释全世界范围内最新的城市生活现实、城市结构及进程,并对城市规划的实践与相关政策进行批判地思考。通过本课程学习,使得学生能够较为深入地掌握城市社会学研究的基本概念与主要内容,并提供学生综合全面地分析城市问题以及批判地理解和评价城市规划的相关实践与政策的理论基础。

The course of "Urban Society, Space and Planning" is a basic theoretical disciplinary subject for postgraduate students. Taking the socio-spatial dialectical relations and application of the socio-spatial theory model as main clue, in addition with global and comparative perspectives, this course is constituted by four parts of urban structure, urbanization, urbanism and urban problems and particular focuses on such issues as worldwide urbanization, multi-centered metropolitan regions, socio-spatial and cultural diversities in metropolitan areas and social problems in metropolitan areas, and likewise. The course illustrates the newest reality in current urban life, urban form and its procession at social, political, economical and cultural dimensions, meanwhile providing critical considerations of practice in the urban planning sphere and its related policies. The general goal of this course is, therefore, to offer an in-depth knowledge of the basic concepts and main contents of urban sociological research, as well as a theoretical approach to comprehensive analysis of key urban issues and critical understanding and evaluation of the related practice and policies of urban planning.
